Child Representation Fee is \$200 per hour

Child Representation Sliding Fee Scale

	Parent's Gross Annual Income	Parent's Hourly Rate
Category #1	\$0 to \$25,000	\$0
Category #2	\$25,001 to \$50,000	\$50
Category #3	\$50,001 to \$100,000	\$100
Category #4	\$100,001 to \$200,000	\$150
Category #5	\$200,001 and above	\$200

Sliding Fee Scale is used ONLY for parents who provide income information and sign a Fee Agreement for monthly billing

If a Fee Agreement is signed using income information provided by parents, fees are assessed to each parent separately based on their income.

Unless otherwise ordered by the Court, each parent is responsible for **one-half** of the billable hours for their child's representation. Each parent will receive a monthly invoice for one-half of the work completed in that month, billed at the parent's individual hourly rate according to the sliding fee scale above.

If a parent does not provide income information and sign a Fee Agreement, services will be billed at \$200/hour.
